## TRAINING

## RESTARTING FOOTBALL STAGE THREE: from July 1st.

This is an UPDATE on the easing of restrictions to be used in conjunction with the initial protocols published and available on the CDSFA web site.

#### WHAT IS PERMITTED:

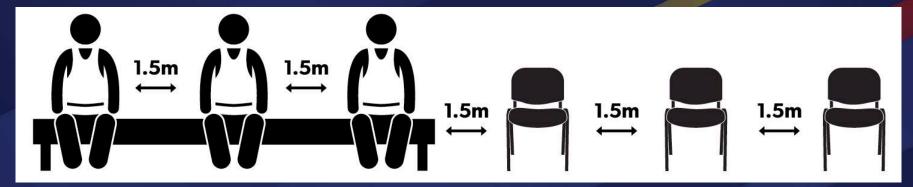
- Full squad training is permitted.
- Contact (tackling & body contact) is permitted.
- Sharing of sporting equipment is permitted but cleaning needs to continue between sessions.
   Bibs can't be shared.
- Social distancing of 1.5m between specators.
- Spacing so that there is no more than 1 person per 4m².(excludes on pitch).

#### WHAT IS **NOT** PERMITTED:

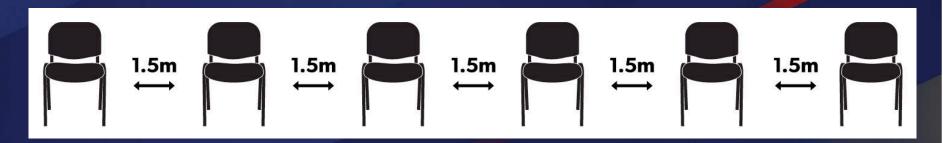
- Change rooms and wet areas are still limited to players and key officials.
- Socialising and remaining after games or activities.
- Team Handshakes pre post games, Team huddles & Hi 5's.
- Multiple Goal celebrations.
- Spitting.
- Bibs can't be shared.
- Non Compliance of Social distancing of 1.5m between specators so that there is no more than 1 person per 4m<sup>2</sup>.(excludes on pitch).



## GAME DAY PROTOCOLS TEAM BENCHES



Where team benches are permanent (fixed), limit number of seats to ensure 1.5 metres between member of the coaching staff and substitutes. Where possible, mark seats with masking tape. If necessary, provide additional seats to extend the length of the bench.



Where team benches are made up of plastic/other moveable chairs, position these so that those seated are at least 1.5 metres apart. Ensure these chairs remain at the required distance apart during and between matches.

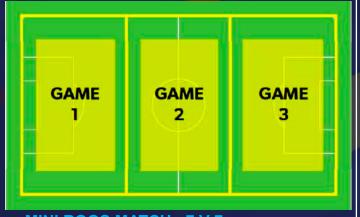

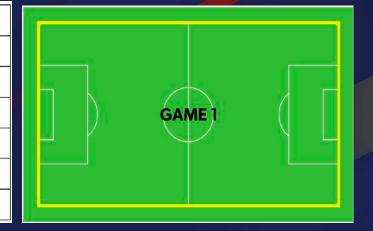
