

2020 POLICY



PLAYER REGISTRATION REFUND POLICY (ASSOC.)

PREAMBLE

A player's total registration fee is made up of a number of components. These being:

1. Football Federation Australia (FFA) National Registration Fee (NRF);
2. Football NSW (FNSW) Capitation, including Insurance;
3. Association Fee; and
4. Club Fee.

The Association, nor Club, have control over the amount set as the FFA NRF or FNSW Capitation.

The FFA NRF and FNSW Capitation once paid is subject to the Terms & Conditions as set out by each of the FFA and FNSW at the time of registration (refer to Terms & Conditions acknowledged in Play Football). FNSW has set a Deregistration Deadline of 30th April in the current year. Any player deregistered after 30th April will be counted by FFA/FNSW in a Club's billing figures.

The Association has no control over the amount set as the Club Fee nor what portion (if any) of that Club Fee is refunded upon de-registration at a particular point in time. Player's should consult their Club as to the Club's refund policy.

Note: No NSW Government Active Kids Voucher fee will be returned to the player (or parent, etc) upon a de-registration.

ASSOCIATION POLICY

This Policy only relates to the Association portion of a player's registration fee when that individual seeks to deregister from the current football season.

1. The only instance where a **full refund** is to be applied is when the player has not engaged in any football activity within the Association, i.e. has not trained, participated in a trial game, or played in a season fixture.
2. There will be **no refund** of the Association fee once the individual has participated in training, a trial game, or season fixture.
3. Where a player sustains a season ending injury (evidence required) during pre-season training or a pre-season trial game, a 50% refund will be provided.
